Summary TeleQuality Communications, Inc. ("TeleQuality"), has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold and facilities-based private line data services throughout Arizona and that its service be classified as competitive. TeleQuality describes the services to be rendered as resold and facilities-based, non-switched, dedicated point-to-point data transport telecommunications services.

The Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") has recommended approval of the application, subject to certain conditions. The Commission will issue a decision regarding the application following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by TeleQuality, Staff, or any intervenors.

About Intervention The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you desire to intervene, you must file an original and 13 copies of a written motion to intervene with the Commission no later than September 10, 2010. You must send a copy of the motion to intervene to TeleQuality or its counsel and to all parties of record. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number and the name, address, and telephone number of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself;
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of TeleQuality, etc.); and
3. A statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to TeleQuality or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before September 10, 2010. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other wit-

nesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the application or from filing written comments in the record of the case. If representation by counsel is required by Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenor's obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. 
