PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 9, 2010, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Temporary Order to Cease and Desist ("T.O.") and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against LaMel G. Young, aka Mel Young, individually and doing business as Powerball Records and Entertainment and Jane Doe Young (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of stock and/or investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On July 20, 2010, a request for hearing was filed by Respondent LaMel Young.

On July 21, 2010, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on August 12, 2010.

On August 11, 2010, the Division filed a Motion to Continue the pre-hearing conference because the attorney of record in this proceeding had to appear before the Commission in an unrelated matter at the same time. The Division's Motion stated that Respondent LaMel Young did not object to the Division's Motion. Subsequently, by Procedural Order, the pre-hearing conference was continued from August 12, 2010 to September 1, 2010.

On August 27, 2010, Respondents filed a request to appear telephonically at the pre-hearing conference. The Division has no objections to Respondents' request.

1 Accordingly, Respondents may appear telephonically.

2 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondents are hereby authorized to appear
3 telephonically at the pre-hearing conference.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondents shall contact the Hearing Division no later
5 than August 31, 2010, at (602) 542-4250 for instructions on how to appear telephonically at the pre-
6 hearing conference scheduled on September 1, 2010.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **pre-hearing conference** scheduled on August 12,
8 2010, shall be continued to **September 1, 2010, at 9:30 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200
9 West Washington Street, Room 100, Phoenix, Arizona, as previously ordered.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 – Unauthorized
11 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
13 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
