PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Procedural Order dated August 12, 2010, the above-captioned matter was set for hearing and a schedule established for the pre-filing of written testimony. Under that schedule, the Intervenor, Mr. Arkoosh, was to file his testimony or legal brief by October 22, 2010, and Staff was file testimony and /or legal brief by November 12, 2010.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **all other dates established in the August 12, 2010 Procedural Order shall remain in effect**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized

1 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
3 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
4 ruling at hearing.


