FOURTH
PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Schedules Hearing)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 9, 2010, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Temporary Order to Cease and Desist ("T.O.") and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against LaMel G. Young, aka Mel Young, individually and doing business as Powerball Records and Entertainment and Jane Doe Young (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of stock and/or investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On July 20, 2010, a request for hearing was filed by Respondent LaMel Young.

On July 21, 2010, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on August 12, 2010.

On August 11, 2010, the Division filed a Motion to Continue the pre-hearing conference because the attorney of record in this proceeding had to appear before the Commission in an unrelated matter at the same time. The Division's Motion stated that Respondent LaMel Young did not object to the Division's Motion. Subsequently, by Procedural Order, the pre-hearing conference was continued from August 12, 2010 to September 1, 2010.

On September 1, 2010, at the pre-hearing conference, the Division appeared with counsel. Respondent, LaMel Young, personally appeared on his own behalf. Although the parties are

1 discussing a resolution of the proceeding, the Division requested that a hearing be scheduled in order
2 to address the issues raised by the T.O. and Notice.

3 Accordingly, a hearing should be scheduled.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED a **hearing** shall be held on **December 2, 2010**, at 10:00 a.m.
5 at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Room 100, Phoenix, Arizona.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall exchange copies of their **Exhibits** and their
7 **Witness Lists** by **November 1, 2010**, with courtesy copies provided to the presiding Administrative
8 Law Judge.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if a Consent Order is approved prior to the hearing, the
10 Division shall file a Motion to Vacate the Hearing.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 – Unauthorized
12 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
14 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*
15 *hac vice*.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
17 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
18 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances
19 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
20 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
21 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
23 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


