**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On June 12, 2002, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Brian Bamman and Bamex International, LTD. (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of commodity investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On June 24, 2002, a request for hearing was filed on behalf of all Respondents.

On June 27, 2002, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled.

On July 8, 2002, the Respondents filed a Motion to Stay ("Motion") the proceeding pending the resolution of a case presently before the Arizona Court of Appeals involving similar issues.

On July 15, 2002, the Division filed its response to the Respondents' Motion arguing that there was insufficient reason to stay the proceeding.

On July 25, 2002, counsel for the parties argued their positions on Respondents' Motion. Additionally, certain other procedural matters were discussed including the scheduling of a hearing and the exchange of witness and exhibit lists.

On July 29, 2002, by Procedural Order, Respondents' Motion was denied and the proceeding scheduled for hearing on September 30, 2002.

1 On September 27, 2002, the Division filed a Motion to Vacate the proceeding pending  
2 approval of a Consent Order by the Commission.

3 Under the circumstances, the Division's Motion to Vacate should be approved pending  
4 approval of the Consent Order by the Commission

5 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Division's Motion to Vacate the hearing be, and is  
6 hereby, granted.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing on the Notice shall be vacated.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Division shall file a Motion to Reschedule the hearing  
9 if the Consent Order is not approved by the Commission.


