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SECOND PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On August 14, 2001, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, for Restitution, for Administrative Penalties, and for Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") against Robert Dale Hylton; Hylton Enterprises, Inc.; Oreo Management Co.; Legend Leasing Co.; Liberty Marketing Co.; and Passport Wholesale Supply (collectively the "Respondents") in which the Division alleged that Respondents have engaged in acts, practices, and

1 transactions that constitute violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act").

2 Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

3 On August 20, 2001 Respondents filed a request for a hearing and a pre-hearing conference.

4 On August 29, 2001, the Commission issued a Procedural Order that set this matter for a pre-  
5 hearing on September 17, 2001.


6 On September 17, 2001, the pre-hearing was held as scheduled. Respondents appeared with  
7 the assistance of counsel. The Division also appeared with counsel. Following discussions between  
8 the parties, it was agreed that a hearing should be scheduled on the issues raised in the Notice on  
9 December 20, 2001. In the interim, the parties agreed to attempt to resolve the issues raised in the  
10 Notice.

12 Accordingly, a hearing should be scheduled to address the issues raised in the Notice and the
