PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On August 14, 2001, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist and Other Relief ("Notice") against 21<sup>st</sup> Century Satellite ("21<sup>st</sup> Century"), Howard Baldwin ("Baldwin"), Glenn A. Liberatore Financial Services ("GLFS") and Glenn A. Liberatore ("Liberatore") (collectively the "Respondents") in which the Division alleged that the Respondents had committed multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On September 18, 2001, Respondents Liberatore and GLFS filed a request for a hearing.

On September 20, 2001, Respondent Baldwin filed a request for a hearing.

On October 10, 2001, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled.

1 On October 31, 2001, during the pre-hearing conference, the issues raised in the Notice, the  
2 length of hearing and scheduling the proceeding, were discussed.

3 Accordingly, a hearing should be scheduled on the allegations raised in the Notice.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing shall commence on April 1, 2002, at 10:00  
5 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall also set aside April 2, 3, 4 and 5, 2002 for  
7 additional days of hearing, if necessary.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall exchange pre-marked witness and exhibit  
9 lists by 4:00 p.m. on March 18, 2002 with a courtesy copy to be provided to the presiding  
10 Administrative Law Judge.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall confer and stipulate to unobjectionable  
12 exhibits prior to the start of the hearing.
