PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 14, 2001, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist and Other Relief ("Notice") against 21st Century Satellite ("21st Century"), Howard Baldwin ("Baldwin"), Glenn A. Liberatore Financial Services ("GLFS") and Glenn A. Liberatore ("Liberatore") (collectively the "Respondents") in which the Division alleged that the Respondents had committed multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On September 18, 2001, Respondents Liberatore and GLFS filed a request for a hearing.

On September 20, 2001, Respondent Baldwin filed a request for a hearing.

On October 10, 2001, by Procedural order, a pre-hearing was scheduled for October 31, 2001.

1 On October 31, 2001, a pre-hearing was held to discuss the conduct of the hearing and its
2 scheduling.

3 On November 20, 2001, by Procedural Order, the hearing was scheduled to commence on
4 April 1, 2002.

5 On March 29, 2002, the Division filed a Motion to Continue the hearing indefinitely pending
6 approval of Consent Orders for the Respondents who had requested hearings.

7 Accordingly, the hearing should be continued indefinitely.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for April 1, 2002 should be
9 continued indefinitely.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Division shall request the hearing to be rescheduled if
11 additional proceedings are necessary.


