**FOURTH PROCEDURAL ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On June 20, 2001, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding the Temporary Order to Cease and Desist and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Aeromax, Inc.; Aeromag Corporation; Lexington Bartlett; and David L. Spears (collectively the "Respondents") in which the Division alleged that Respondents have engaged in acts, practices, and transactions that constitute violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act").

The Respondents were all duly served with copies of the Notice.

On July 10, 2001, Respondents, through their attorney, filed a request for a hearing.

On July 16, 2001, the Commission issued a Procedural Order that set this matter for a pre-hearing conference on July 26, 2001.

On July 23, 2001, the Commission received a Motion to Continue the hearing scheduled for

1 July 26, 2001 from the Respondents.

2       On July 25, 2001, the Commission granted the continuance and issued a Procedural Order that  
3 reset the pre-hearing conference for August 9, 2001.

4       On August 9, 2001, the pre-hearing was held as scheduled. Respondents were represented by  
5 counsel. The Division also appeared with counsel. Following discussions between the parties, it was  
6 agreed that a hearing should be scheduled for November 26, 2001. In the interim, the parties agreed  
7 to attempt to resolve the issues raised by the Notice.

8       On August 20, 2001, the Commission issued a Procedural Order that set this matter for a  
9 hearing on November 26, 2001.

10       On November 20, 2001, the Division filed a Motion to Continue this matter. In the Motion,  
11 the Division indicates that it has entered into a proposed Consent Order with all of the Respondents  
12 and that those proposed Consent Orders are currently set to be heard by the Commission at the  
13 December 2001 Open Meeting. Respondents do not object to the continuance.

14       The Commission finds that a continuance is in the interests of justice; that it is not intended to  
15 delay the proceedings; that all parties have agreed to the continuance; and that all applicable time  
16 limits are waived in this matter. Accordingly, the hearing should be rescheduled.

17       IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing on the above-captioned matter set for  
18 November 26, 2001 shall be vacated and the hearing is continued until February 12, 2002, at 10:00  
19 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

20       IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall exchange witness lists and exhibits not  
21 later than 10 days before the hearing and provide a copy of same to the presiding Administrative Law  
22 Judge, unless otherwise ordered by the Administrative Law Judge.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondents shall comply with the Temporary Cease and  
2 Desist Order until the issuance of a Decision by the Commission in this matter.
