PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On October 31, 2001, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, For Restitution, For Administrative Penalties, and For Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") against Grand Canyon Wagon Adventure Tours, Inc. ("Grand Canyon"), and Floyd Willard Dwiggins, Jr. (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division alleged that the Respondents had committed multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of stock.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On November 13, 2001, Respondents filed a request for a hearing.

On November 14, 2001, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled.

On December 5, 2001, the pre-hearing conference was held with counsel for the Respondents and the Division present. The proceeding was scheduled for hearing upon agreement of the parties to take place on February 13 and 14, 2002.

On February 4, 2002, Respondents and the Division filed a Stipulation to continue the proceeding until April 22, 2002 pending the submission of a Consent Order to the Commission for

1 approval.

2 Accordingly, the hearing should be continued to allow for the submission of the Consent  
3 Order to the Commission for its approval.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing in this proceeding shall be continued from  
5 February 13, 2002 at 9:30 a.m. to April 22, 2002 at 9:30 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200  
6 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall also reserve April 23, 2002, for additional  
8 hearing time, if necessary.


