**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On October 31, 2001, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, For Restitution, For Administrative Penalties, and For Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") against Grand Canyon Wagon Adventure Tours, Inc. ("Grand Canyon"), and Floyd Willard Dwiggins, Jr. (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division alleged that the Respondents had committed multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of stock.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On November 13, 2001, Respondents filed a request for a hearing.

On November 14, 2001, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled.

On December 5, 2001, the pre-hearing conference was held with counsel for the Respondents and the Division present. The proceeding was scheduled for hearing upon agreement of the parties to take place on February 13 and 14, 2002.

On February 4, 2002, Respondents and the Division filed a Stipulation to continue the proceeding until April 22, 2002 pending the submission of a Consent Order to the Commission for

1 approval.

2 On February 5, 2002, by Procedural Order, the hearing was continued from February 13, 2002  
3 to April 22, 2002 to allow for the submission of the proposed Consent Order to the Commission for  
4 its approval.

5 On April 19, 2002, the Division filed a Motion to Continue ("Motion") the hearing date from  
6 April 22, 2002 to a later date because the proposed Consent Order will not be addressed by the  
7 Commission until the Open Meeting of May 23, 2002. The Division indicated that the Respondent  
8 concurs with this request.

9 Accordingly, the hearing should be vacated to allow for the submission of the Consent Order  
10 to the Commission for its approval. In the event that the Consent order is not approved, the Division  
11 should request the proceeding be rescheduled for hearing.

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing in this proceeding shall be vacated until  
13 further Order by the Commission, if necessary.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Securities Division shall request the proceeding be  
15 rescheduled if the proposed Consent Order is not approved by the Commission.


