11 The Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission
12 ("Commission") hereby moves the Commission, through the Administrative Law Judge, Philip J.
13 Dion III, to schedule a Pre-Hearing Status Conference to discuss the status of the hearing in this
14 matter that is scheduled to begin on Monday September 23, 2002, at 10 a.m., to discuss the
15 attendance of Respondent at the hearing and to discuss the status of a Temporary Cease and
16 Desist Order that Respondent was previously ordered to sign by the Commission.

17 Last week, Respondent was taken into custody on a warrant for his arrest. The warrant
18 for Respondent's arrest was issued when he failed to appear on July 23, 2002, for his arraignment
19 on criminal charges in Superior Court, Maricopa County. Respondent is currently in custody at
20 the Durango Jail, Maricopa County. Respondent's booking number is A852098. Respondent's
21 next court date in Superior Court is a Pre-Trial Conference on October 11, 2002.

22 By Procedural Order of the Commission dated June 21, 2002, Respondent was ordered to
23 enter into a signed Temporary Cease and Desist Order as a condition of the hearing in this matter
24 being continued. Respondent never signed the Temporary Cease and Desist Order delivered to
25 his attorney's office.
