PROCEDURAL ORDER

14 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

15 On August 23, 2002, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation
16 Commission ("Commission") filed a Temporary Order to Cease and Desist ("T.O.") and a Notice of
17 Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Turn Two Trading Club ("TTTC"), Dennis Wayne Little
18 and Deborah L. Sorenson Little (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple
19 violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") and the Investment Management Act ("IMA") in
20 connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts. As a result of the
21 T.O., the Respondents were immediately ordered to cease and desist from violating the Act and the
22 IMA.

23 The Respondents were duly served with copies of the T.O. and Notice.

24 On September 10, 2002, a request for hearing was filed on behalf of the Respondents, but
25 without an Answer pursuant to A.A.C. R14-4-305.

26 On September 12, 2002, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled for
27 October 8, 2002.

28 On September 23, 2002, Respondents filed an Answer.

1 On October 8, 2002, the Division and the Respondents appeared at the pre-hearing
2 conference. The parties agreed to a hearing beginning on December 16, 2002, and to exchange
3 Witness and Exhibit Lists prior to the hearing.


4 Accordingly, a hearing should be scheduled to address the issues raised in the T.O. and


