PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 12, 2002, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, for Restitution, for Administrative Penalties, and For Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") against Ralph Shaul and Leslie Shaul ("Respondents") in which the Division alleged that Respondent have engaged in acts, practices, and transactions that constitute violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act").

On February 20, 2003, Respondents, through their attorney, filed a request for a hearing and a pre-hearing conference.

On February 26, 2003, the Commission, by Procedural Order, scheduled a pre-hearing conference for April 7, 2003 in this matter.

On April 7, 2003, the pre-hearing was held as scheduled. The Respondents and the Division appeared with counsel. Following discussions between the parties, it was agreed that a hearing should be scheduled for July 28, 2003. In the interim, the parties agreed to attempt to resolve the issues raised in the Notice.

1 On April 23, 2003, by Procedural Order, a hearing was scheduled for July 28, 2003.

2 On July 2, 2003, counsel for Respondents filed a Motion to Continue the hearing. In the
3 Motion, counsel stated Respondents need additional time to pursue further settlement discussions
4 with the Division. The Division does not oppose this continuance.

5 Accordingly, the hearing should be rescheduled.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing on the above-captioned matter scheduled for
7 July 28, 2003, shall be vacated and continued until November 18, 2003 at 10:00 a.m., at the
8 Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall also set aside November 19 and 20, 2003
10 for additional days of hearing, if necessary.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall exchange witness lists and exhibits not
12 later than 10 days before the hearing and provide a copy of same to the presiding Administrative Law
13 Judge.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule is still in effect.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend or waive
16 any portion of this Procedural Order by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


