PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 14, 2003, counsel for Respondent Elliot Crosby filed a Motion to Continue the hearing currently scheduled for January 20, 2003. The Motion states that Respondent's counsel and the Securities Division's counsel are engaged in serious, good faith settlement negotiations, and that as part of those negotiations, Respondent is assembling voluminous financial and other personal materials the Securities Division has requested that he provide. The Motion further states that the global settlement being discussed will involve the Department of Insurance and the Department of Real Estate, and that the Securities Division agrees with Respondent that the requested document production and review cannot be accomplished prior to the scheduled hearing date of January 20, 2003. The Motion states that Respondent would waive any speedy hearing rights occasioned by the continuance, and avows that counsel for the Securities Division does not oppose a continuance of the hearing for 60-90 days for purposes of settlement.

Accordingly, the hearing scheduled in this matter should be continued.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing set for January 20, 2004 is continued to April 12, 2004 at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall exchange witness lists and any exhibits not

1 previously exchanged, and provide a copy of same to the presiding Administrative Law Judge, no
2 later than March 29, 2004.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule remains in effect.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend or waive
5 any portion of this Procedural Order by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


