PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 17, 2003, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, for Restitution, for Administrative Penalties, and for Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") against Wesley Karban Wyatt and Jane Doe Wyatt in which the Division alleged that they engaged in acts, practices and transactions that constitute violation of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act").

On September 8, 2003, the Commission issued a Procedural Order that, among other things, ordered the Division to provide Jane Doe Wyatt with a copy of the Notice and all of the filings in this matter on or before December 15, 2003, if the Division intended to proceed in this matter against Jane Doe Wyatt. The Procedural Order also ordered the Division to docket an affidavit indicating proof of service on Jane Doe Wyatt.

As of today's date, the Division has not docketed proof that it has served the Notice and other information upon Jane Doe Wyatt.

Accordingly, Jane Doe Wyatt should be dismissed from this matter without prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Jane Doe Wyatt is dismissed from this action without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing set for January 26, 2004 is affirmed.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule is still in effect.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend or waive
3 any portion of this Procedural Order by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.

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
