PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 17, 2003, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, for Restitution, for Administrative Penalties, and for Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") against Wesley Karban Wyatt and Jane Doe Wyatt in which the Division alleged that they engaged in acts, practices and transactions that constitute violation of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act").

On September 8, 2003, the Commission issued a Procedural Order that set this matter for a hearing on January 26, 2004.

On January 26, 2004, the hearing commenced as scheduled. The Division appeared with the assistance of counsel. Mr. Wyatt's attorney, Harry Stone, also appeared on behalf of Mr. Wyatt. At the start of the hearing, the parties stated that they had reached a settlement, and asked that this matter be continued indefinitely.

Accordingly, the hearing set for January 26, 2004 should be continued indefinitely.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing set for January 26, 2004 on the above-captioned proceeding shall be continued indefinitely pending submission of a Consent Order for Commission approval.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event a settlement is not reached, the Division shall

1 request that a hearing be rescheduled if necessary.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule is still in effect.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend or waive
4 any portion of this Procedural Order by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


