RE: JOHNSON UTILITIES COMPANY DOCKET NOS. **WS-02987A-99-0583** AND WS-02987A-00-0618 DECISION NO. 64062 – REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLY

In Decision No. 64062 (amended), the Commission, as a condition to the issuance of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, ordered Johnson Utilities Company (Johnson) to file, within 30 days of the anniversary date of the Commission's Decision each year for the next two years, documentation from the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) indicating that it has been in compliance with the ADEQ for each year. Failure to submit this documentation in the Docket within the time specified would result in the Certificate becoming null and void without further order of the Commission. This Compliance filing was due on November 4, 2002.

On November 8, 2002, Johnson filed a request for a 60 day extension of time to comply so that it may obtain from the ADEQ documentation that it is in compliance. Staff has no objections to the request and recommends that Johnson be granted an extension of time to January 3, 2003.


