REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE

The Company requests that the Arizona Corporation Commission continue an item currently scheduled for the Commission's Open Meetings on September 21, 2010 or September 22, 2010 to consider the Implementation of an Infrastructure Surcharge Mechanism.

The Company previously submitted a request to reopen the above referenced Dockets to modify Decision 71234, pursuant to ARS § 40-252. That request has yet to be heard.

1 To pay for new storage capacity, the Company applied for and was approved for a
2 loan in the amount of \$145,877 from the Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of
3 Arizona (WIFA).

4 Prior to the closing of the loan, the United States Environmental Protection
5 Agency issued a memorandum declaring that all loans issued by WIFA must comply with
6 Davis-Bacon Act Wage Requirements. To comply with all of the requirements of Davis-
7 Bacon, the contractor selected by the Company was forced to revise upward the costs
8 needed to install the new storage capacity.

9 The Company has had discussions with WIFA officials who indicate that the
10 additional funds to pay for the project would be available if the additional debt authority
11 is received from the Commission.

12 The additional costs to comply with Davis-Bacon requirements and newly
13 imposed Arizona Department of Environment Quality review fees amount to \$14,123.
14 The Company now requires authority to borrow a total of \$160,000 to complete the
15 storage project.

16 The Company respectfully requests the Commission continue and delay
17 consideration of the Implementation of an Infrastructure Surcharge Mechanism until such time
18 as the Commission has had the opportunity to review reopening the above referenced Dockets to
19 modify Decision 71234 to consider an increase the total debt authorization.
