**STAFF'S NOTICE OF FILING
CLARIFICATION TO THE
RECOMMENDED OPINION AND
ORDER**

The Utilities Division ("Staff") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") respectfully submits the following clarifications in response to the Recommended Opinion and Order ("ROO") for Johnson Utilities Company ("Johnson" or "Company") issued by Administrative Law Judge Teena Jibilian on September 9, 2010.

On Exhibit A, Water Division, Service Line and Meter Installation Charges, because there is no approved Off-Site Facilities Hook-up fee or CAP Hook-up fee, Staff would request that those references be deleted along with the corresponding footnotes (d) and (e). For the service charge relating to "Customer Requested," the incorrect rule is referenced. Staff would note that the reference should be R14-2-405B. Again, in footnote (c), the incorrect Rule is referenced. The rule that should be referenced is R14-2-403D. Finally, there is a small typographical error in the very last sentence, an "R" should be inserted before "14-2-409 (D) (5)."

On Exhibit A, Wastewater Division, the service charge for after-hours service references the incorrect rule. Staff would request that the reference be changed to rule R14-2-604D. Staff would also note that in footnote (b) the incorrect rule is referenced. Staff would request that reference be changed to "R14-2-603(b)." In footnote (c) the incorrect rule is referenced. Staff would request the

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1 reference be corrected to be "R14-2-603(D)." Finally, in the last sentence there is a small
2 typographical error, the reference to the rule should be R14-2-608(D) (5).

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
