**FIFTH**  
**PROCEDURAL ORDER**  
**(Vacates Hearing)**

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 9, 2010, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Temporary Order to Cease and Desist ("T.O.") and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against LaMel G. Young, aka Mel Young, individually and doing business as Powerball Records and Entertainment and Jane Doe Young (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of stock and/or investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On July 20, 2010, a request for hearing was filed by Respondent LaMel Young.

On July 21, 2010, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on August 12, 2010.

On August 11, 2010, the Division filed a Motion to Continue the pre-hearing conference because the attorney of record in this proceeding had to appear before the Commission in an unrelated matter at the same time. The Division's Motion stated that Respondent LaMel Young did not object to the Division's Motion. Subsequently, by Procedural Order, the pre-hearing conference was continued from August 12, 2010 to September 1, 2010.

On September 1, 2010, at the pre-hearing conference, the Division appeared with counsel. Respondent, LaMel Young, personally appeared on his own behalf. The parties were discussing a

1 resolution of the proceeding, but the Division requested that a hearing be scheduled in the interim.

2 On September 1, 2010, by Procedural Order, a hearing was scheduled on December 2, 2010.

3 On October 7, 2010, at the Commission's Open Meeting, a Consent Order with respect to this  
4 proceeding was approved by the Commission.

5 On October 8, 2010, the Division filed a Motion to Vacate Hearing.

6 Accordingly, the hearing scheduled on December 2, 2010, should be vacated.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED the hearing scheduled to be held on December 2, 2010, is  
8 hereby vacated.


