**REQUEST FOR SUSPENSION OF THE  
THIRTY DAY TIME CLOCK**

The Utilities Division of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Staff") hereby requests a suspension of the 30 day time clock to allow Staff sufficient time to request a longer 120 day suspension of the filing period at the November 22nd through November 23rd, 2010 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") Open Meeting.


On October 4, 2010, Little Park Water Company, Inc. ("Company") filed an application requesting authority to reinstate an Arsenic Hook-up Fee Tariff. Prior to this, on September 27, 2010, in Docket No. W-02192A-10-0395, the Company requested authority to incur \$140,000 in new long-term debt to repay a bridge loan it received from its parent to fund construction of an arsenic treatment facility. The Company states that the purpose of the requested tariff is to reduce the future impact of the new investment in plant and to generate additional funds to repay the long-term debt.

Pursuant to ARS § 40-367, tariff filings become effective after 30 days notice. Staff has not had adequate time to review and analyze the application and to consider any interrelated implications with the financing request. Subsequent to the instant Request for Suspension Of the Thirty Day Time Clock, Staff will be filing, for consideration at the November, 2010 Open Meeting a memorandum and recommended opinion and order asking the Commission to grant a suspension for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days through and including March 17, 2011 for consideration of this application.

The Company has indicated to Staff that it does not oppose the instant request for suspension of the thirty day time clock. Thus Staff requests the Administrative Law Judge to grant a suspension

3 November 22nd through November 23rd, 2010.
