PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 4, 2010, Little Park Water Company, Inc. ("Little Park") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission"), in the above-captioned docket, an Application to Reinstate Arsenic Hook-Up Fee Tariff.

On October 27, 2010, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Request for Suspension of the Thirty Day Time Clock in this docket, to prevent Little Park's tariff filing from automatically becoming effective after 30 days notice pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-367. Staff explained that Staff will be filing a Memorandum and Recommended Opinion and Order for the Commission's Consideration at the November 2010 Open Meeting, in which Staff will request that the time frame in this docket be suspended for 120 days, until March 17, 2011, to allow Staff additional time to consider this tariff filing in light of another docket in which Little Park has requested authority to incur \$140,000 in new long-term debt. Staff stated that the 30-day time period does not allow Staff adequate time to review and analyze the tariff filing and to consider any interrelated implications with the financing request. Staff asserted that Little Park has indicated that it does not oppose Staff's request for a 30-day suspension of the time clock in this matter.

Because Little Park does not object to Staff's request for a 30-day suspension of the time clock in this matter, and because the suspension will allow Staff to have its request for a longer suspension considered by the Commission at an Open Meeting, it is reasonable and appropriate to grant the 30-day suspension requested by Staff.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **time clock in this matter is hereby suspended for**
2 **30 days.**

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
4 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


