It appears that Goodman Water Company is an Arizona State sanctioned Monopoly that is using its (our) money and its political contacts to abuse its control over what is supposed to be a utility to force unregulated water rates and fees down our throat.

Due to there last rate increase sanctioned by the Arizona Corporation Commission our water rates are already higher than any where in Pima or Pinal County.

I pay over \$105.00 dollars per month just for the privilege of having the Goodman Water Company's water meter that is without using one drop of water. \$1260.00 per year just for the meter.

No Where have I ever heard of such Highway Robbery this is not the old west any more. How many times do I have to pay for this meter, that buy the way cost less than \$600.00?

They now propose to raise the monthly meter rate to \$142.00 PER MONTH and increase my already astronomically high monthly bill from \$158 to \$240 a 51.69% increase.

My friends in Oro Valley only pay \$47.00 per month for the same water use and they do not pay a meter fee.

Due to Goodman Water Company's structuring allowed by Arizona Corporation Commission, they are allowed to hire lawyers to fight our companies against them and then force us to pay the fees. This is corrupt and unjust.
