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2. Whether Staff's proposed clarifications and modifications to the Settlement should be adopted by the Commission as conditions for approval.

More specifically, Staff will address the matters set forth in its prefiled testimony, including the following major areas:

1. Unbundling of tariffs;
2. Market generation credit and its relationship to the CTC;
3. Clarifying the proposed adjustor mechanisms;
4. Evaluation of benefits of rate reductions;
5. Criteria for impacting development of a competitive generation market;
6. Amount and manner of collection of of stranded cost;
7. Transfer of APS' generation assets to an affiliate; and
8. Commission approvals and requested waivers.

Staff also reserves the opportunity to address subject areas covered by other parties in either their prefiled testimony or cross-examination.
