PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 6, 1999, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 61973, in which the Commission ordered Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") to file a revised proposed Code of Conduct for Commission approval within 30 days of the date of Decision No. 61973.

In October 28, 1999, APS filed with the Commission a revised proposed Code of Conduct for Commission approval, and indicated that it had sent copies to the parties of record in the above captioned matters.

Pursuant to Decision No. 61973 interested parties have 60 days from the effective date of that Decision to provide comments to APS regarding its revised Code of Conduct, and further, that APS shall file a final proposed Code of Conduct within 90 days of the effective date of Decision No. 61973. Decision No. 61973 provides that the Hearing Division will establish a procedural schedule to hear the matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that interested parties, including Commission Utilities Division Staff shall provide comments on APS' revised proposed Code of Conduct by December 6, 1999, and shall file copies of such comments with the Commission.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that APS shall file a final proposed Code of Conduct by
2 January 5, 2000.


3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a hearing for the approval of APS' proposed Code of

7 at 1 p.m. at the Commission's offices in Phoenix, Arizona.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff and other interested parties shall file comments
9 concerning APS' final proposed Code of Conduct by January 18, 2000.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
11 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


