On September 18, 2009, Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC" or "Cooperative") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an order to institute a moratorium on new connections to the V-7 feeder line serving the Whetstone, Rain Valley, Elgin, Canelo, Sonoita, and Patagonia, Arizona areas ("Affected Area") in Docket No. E-01575A-09-0453 ("Moratorium Application"). On September 28, 2009, pursuant to A.R.S. §40-253 and A.A.C. R14-3-111, SSVEC filed with the Commission an Application for Rehearing and Reconsideration of Commission Decision No. 71274 dated September 8, 2009, in Docket

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
1 No. E-01575A-08-0328 (“Reconsideration Application”).<sup>1</sup> On January 14, 2010, SSVEC  
2 filed with the Commission a Petition to Amend Decision No. 71274 Pursuant to A.R.S.  
3 §40-252 and for Related Authorization (“252 Petition”). In its 252 Petition, SSVEC  
4 indicated that if the Commission granted the relief requested in the 252 Petition, the  
5 Cooperative would withdraw its Moratorium and Reconsideration Applications following  
6 the Commission’s issuance of a final and non-appealable order.<sup>2</sup>

7 On July 12, 2010, the Commission issued Decision No. 71794 (“252 Order”)  
8 which granted the relief requested by the Cooperative in its 252 Petition. On August 23,  
9 2010, the 252 Order became a final order of the Commission pursuant to A.R.S. §40-253.  
10 On September 23, 2010, the 252 Order became non-appealable pursuant to A.R.S. §40-  
11 254.

12 On the basis of the foregoing, SSVEC hereby requests withdrawal of its  
13 Moratorium Application and its Application for Rehearing and Reconsideration.


