I strongly urge you to deny the water rate increase because:

1. the company is making a profit during the time of a recession; while most companies are losing money.
2. The retired users of the water have not received an increase in their social security for the second year in a row. Retired military did not receive an increase this year and probably not next year.
3. The state created monopoly is not in the best interest of the consumer:

a. Tucson Water has just completed construction of two large storage tanks 1/4 mile south of the eagle crest ranch community which is the only client of Goodman. Last year I lived in a home that was served by Tucson Water and the water portion of the bill was less than \$20 for the last full billing month in the house; for the same water usage we now pay \$90 to goodman.

b. Lago Del Oro Water to the east has rates about 25% of Goodman.

c. Our subdivision is not out in no man's land. Yet we are paying the rate of an isolated community. If Goodman can't provide water at an honest rate; then sell it to Tucson Water.
