PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 2, 2010, Granite Mountain Water Company, Inc. ("Granite Mountain") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Finance Application, requesting authority to obtain \$181,320 in long-term debt, with \$108,792 to come from a loan from the Water Infrastructure and Finance Authority of Arizona ("WIFA") and the remaining \$72,528 to come from a loan from National Bank of Arizona. Granite Mountain stated that the long-term debt is being obtained to fund replacement of its Well #5 (ADWR #55-622083) and construction of Tank #3 (a 50,000-gallon tank). Granite Mountain further stated that if WIFA does not authorize a loan in the full amount of \$108,792, Granite Mountain will seek to make up the difference by increasing the amount of the loan from National Bank of Arizona. In its application, Granite Mountain provided a copy of notice of its application along with an affidavit by Matthew Lauterbach, Granite Mountain's Water Administrator, certifying that notice had been provided to Granite Mountain's customers on November 30, 2010.

The notice provided by Granite Mountain includes several errors that should be corrected in another notice sent to Granite Mountain's customers, to ensure that the customers are provided accurate information about the application and are provided the information necessary to contact the Commission by phone concerning the application and to file written public comments in this docket. Specifically, Granite Mountain needs to make the following revisions to its notice:

- 1 • On page 11, between lines 3 and 4, "November 30th" should be replaced with
- 2 "December 2";
- 3 • On page 11, line 5, "a loan" should be replaced with "long-term debt";
- 4 • On page 11, between lines 6 and 7, "The" should be deleted;
- 5 • On page 11, line 8, "GMWC" should be replaced with "Granite Mountain";
- 6 • On page 11, between lines 19 and 20, the word "either" should be replaced with "the"
- 7 both places it appears;
- 8 • On page 11, between lines 20 and 21, the local Phoenix phone number for the
- 9 Commission's Consumer Services Section should be corrected to read "602-542-
- 10 4251" (as the "1" is currently separated on a different line);
- 11 • On page 11, between lines 21 and 22, the Docket Number should be corrected to read
- 12 "W-02467A-10-0483";
- 13 • On page 11, line 22, "A2" should be corrected to read "AZ"; and
- 14 • On page 12, between lines 3 and 4, in item number 3, "applications" should be
- 15 replaced with "application".

16 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Granite Mountain shall make the revisions described**
17 **above to its notice and shall, by January 21, 2011, mail the revised notice to all of its current**
18 **customers at their billing addresses.**

19 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Granite Mountain shall, by February 4, 2011, file with**
20 **the Commission's Docket Control, in the Docket Number for this case, a copy of its revised**
21 **notice along with an affidavit certifying that the revised notice has been mailed to its current**
22 **customers as ordered above.**

23 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized**
24 **Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's**
25 **Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.**


