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PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

At a Special Open Meeting held on April 14, 1999, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") ordered the Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") to forward proposed Rules R14-2-201 through -207, -210 and -212, and R14-2-1601 through -1618 ("Proposed Rules") to the Office of the Secretary of State for Notice of Proposed Rulemaking as soon as possible. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, although comments in this matter will be taken through June 17, 1999, all interested parties (including Staff) are requested to file written comments with the Commission's Docket Control Center on or before May 14, 1999 at noon.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, although comments in this matter will be taken through June 17, 1999, all interested parties (including Staff) are requested to file, on or before June 4, 1999 at noon, their written response to those comments filed on or before May 14, 1999.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the responsive written comments shall specifically identify
2 the initial written comments responded to.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that both the initial written comments and the responsive
4 written comments shall refer to specific sections of the Proposed Rules, and shall provide specific
5 suggested language changes.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that both the initial written comments and the responsive
7 written comments shall contain an evaluation of the impact that any suggested change may have on
8 other sections of the Proposed Rules.
