PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

At the February 23, 2000 Status Conference, Navaopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Navopache") and the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") Staff ("Staff") reported they have negotiated a settlement that resolved all but one or two minor issues related to Navopache's recovery of stranded costs. Navopache has circulated among interested parties a draft of the proposed Settlement Agreement and had discussions with those parties who responded. Navopache and Staff opined that the matter should be set for hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Navopache and Staff shall jointly file their Settlement Agreement by March 17, 2000. In the event the Settlement Agreement does not resolve all issues related to Navopache's recovery of stranded costs, Navopache and Staff shall also file a statement that sets forth the remaining issue(s).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a hearing on the proposed Settlement Agreement and any unresolved issues shall commence on **April 5, 2000** at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Navopache and Staff shall file a list of witnesses in support of the Settlement Agreement on or before 10:00 a.m. on March 30, 2000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a telephonic pre-hearing conference for the purpose of discussing the conduct of the hearing shall commence on March 30, 2000, at 10:00 a.m. at the
