**PROCEDURAL ORDER**  
**(Schedules a Pre-hearing Conference)**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On December 8, 2010, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Rob Thomas Hitchcock (CRD #2946739), individually and doing business as Pillar Investment Services ("Pillar"), a dissolved Arizona corporation, and Shelly Hitchcock, husband and wife (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") and the Arizona Investment Management Act ("IM Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of notes. Respondent Rob Hitchcock's spouse, Shelly Hitchcock, was joined in the action for purposes of determining the liability of the marital community.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On December 27, 2010, Respondent, Rob Hitchcock, filed a request for hearing in this matter.

Accordingly, a pre-hearing conference should be scheduled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED a **pre-hearing conference** shall be held on **January 20, 2011, at 11:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room 1, Phoenix, Arizona.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized Communications) is in effect and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules  
2 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission  
3 *pro hac vice*.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance  
5 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the  
6 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances  
7 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is  
8 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the  
9 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,  
11 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by  
12 ruling at hearing.


