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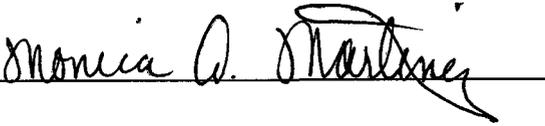

**SAMPLE ORDER AMENDING
DECISION NO. 71914**

Open Meeting
January 11 and 12, 2011
Phoenix, Arizona

BY THE COMMISSION:

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 30, 2010, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 71914 which authorized UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNSE" or "Company") to increase its rates and made certain other findings. During the Commission's deliberations at its September 22, 2010, Open Meeting, the Company's line extension policy was discussed including an amendment proposed by Commissioner Stump ("Stump Proposed Amendment No. 1") that would have returned UNSE's extension policy to a free 400 foot allowance, as the policy existed prior to the issuance of Decision No. 70360 which eliminated the free footage allowance.

2. On January 4, 2011, at its Staff Open Meeting, the Commission voted to reopen Decision No. 71914, pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-252, for the limited purpose of considering amending the Decision to adopt Commissioner Stump's Proposed Amendment No. 1, as discussed at the September 22, 2010, Open Meeting. The Commissioners indicated that a hearing on this matter

1 would be conducted at its regular Open Meeting scheduled for January 11 and 12, 2011, and directed
2 the Hearing Division to issue a Procedural Order inviting interested parties to file comments prior to
3 the hearing and Open Meeting. The Commissioners stated that additional verbal testimony could be
4 permitted at the hearing and an administrative law judge may preside over the taking of additional
5 testimony, following which deliberations would commence to consider Commissioner Stump's
6 Proposed Amendment No. 1. Finally, the Commissioners indicated that requests for additional time
7 would be considered.

8 3. On January 6, 2011, a Procedural Order was issued stating that "all interested parties
9 wishing to comment regarding Commissioner Stump's Proposed Amendment No. 1, are encouraged
10 to file comments, or a summary of comments, in writing, by no later than January 10, 2011, pursuant
11 to the limited reopening of Decision No. 71914 under A.R.S. § 40-252, as approved at the January 4,
12 2011, Staff Open Meeting." The Procedural Order also indicated that additional verbal testimony
13 might be taken at the hearing, following which deliberations would commence to consider
14 Commissioner Stump's Proposed Amendment No. 1.

15 4. At the January 11, 2011, Open Meeting, the Commission received additional
16 information regarding this matter and voted to amend Decision No. 71914 in the following manner:
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22 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

23 1. UNSE is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona
24 Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-250, 40-251 and 40-252.

25 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over UNSE and the subject matter of the issues
26 addressed herein.

27 3. It is reasonable and in the public interest to amend Decision No. 71914, pursuant to
28 the authority granted by A.R.S. § 40-252, in the manner described herein.

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ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Decision No. 71914 is hereby amended as described hereinabove.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects, Decision No. 71914 shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
