Ladies and Gentleman,
 I have a long standing complaint with the Truxton Canyon Water Company and here we go again. My problem is simple, 5 psi of water.
 I spoke with Mike Neal about two weeks ago and was told I would be contacted about hooking my residence to the new line which is 40 feet way from my property. Marcus Neal and I discussed where the meter would be set over a year ago. I was sandbagged then and now as well.
 I have just learned that the company is under order to review their system and they'll have 120 days to comply. This certainly explains why I have been blown off.
 When I spoke with Mike he knew this 120 day reprieve was coming so why worry with me?
 I still have 5 psi and have to use a electric pump just to water the animals and take a shower.
 I feel that my government has let me down.
 Mine is a simple request and doesn't require any engineering studies, just a permit from the county.
 A fire here will be devastating, NO WATER PRESSURE!
 Truxton has at least 6 months and possibly a year.
 I will now have to find a reserve tank and work on my own water system to increase pressure and storage.
 I am truly disappointed with my government.
