**PROCEDURAL ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE FOR SCHEDULING REHEARING OF DECISION NO. 72043**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On December 10, 2011, the Commission issued Decision No. 72043 in this docket.

On December 30, 2010, Mohave Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Mohave" or "Respondent") timely filed an Application for Rehearing of Decision No. 72043 pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-253.

On January 11, 2011, Bureau of Indian Affairs, United States of America, ("BIA" or "Complainant") filed a response to Mohave's Application for Rehearing.

On January 18, 2011, the Commission voted to grant Mohave's Application for Rehearing of Decision No. 72043 pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-253. The Commission ordered the Hearing Division to issue a procedural order scheduling a procedural conference for the purpose of setting a procedural schedule for the rehearing proceeding, and to prepare a Recommended Order on Rehearing for Commission consideration.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **procedural conference** for the purpose of setting a procedural schedule for the rehearing on Decision No. 72043 is hereby scheduled to commence on **January 25, 2011, at 1:30 p.m.**, or as soon as practicable thereafter, at the Commission's offices, 1200 W. Washington, Room 100, Phoenix, Arizona.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules  
2 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*  
3 *hac vice*.


4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
5 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the  
6 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at all  
7 hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled  
8 for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the  
9 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
11 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the  
12 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,  
14 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
15 hearing.
