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

On September 17, 2010, Goodman Water Company ("Goodman" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an increase in annual revenues of \$291,083, or 50.82 percent over test year revenues. Under the rates as proposed by the Company, a residential customer with a 5/8 x 3/4" meter, with an average monthly usage of 5,477 gallons, would see a monthly increase of \$35.46, or 53.14 percent, from \$66.73 to \$102.19. A customer's bill depends on meter size and how much water is used each month. A customer with a larger meter and/or using less or more than the average would experience a smaller or larger increase.

Neither the Commission's Utilities Division Staff nor the Residential Utility Consumer Office have yet made a recommendation regarding the Company's rate proposal, and the Commission will determine the appropriate rate relief to be granted based on the evidence of record in this proceeding. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Company, Staff, or any intervenors and, therefore, the final rates approved in this docket may be lower or higher than the rates described above.

About Intervention

2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, etc.).
