PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 5, 1999, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 61311 which stayed the Retail Electric Competition Rules ("Rules"). In addition, Decision No. 61311 ordered the Hearing Division to establish a Procedural Order to begin consideration of further comment and actions in this docket.

As a result of Decision No. 61311, it is clear that the Commission intends to resolve the remaining issues in electric industry restructuring in a timely manner but with an open process that insures input from all interested parties¹ and Affected Utilities.

Pursuant to Decision No. 61311 and A.A.C. R14-3-109, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern the preparation of this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all interested parties (including Staff) and Affected Utilities shall file comments and provide copies to all interested parties and Affected Utilities no later than 4:00 p.m. on January 20, 1999, setting forth the following:

- A) What issues still need to be resolved in the electric industry restructuring;
- B) The order in which the issues should be resolved;
- C) The method (such as informal discussions by parties/hearings/combinations/etc) and timing to resolve the issues identified; and

¹ On January 4, 1999, the Attorney General's Office and the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") filed a suggested procedural schedule for resolution of the remaining issues in electric industry restructure. The City of Tucson and the Arizona Community Action Association supported those portions of the procedural schedule they had reviewed.

D) Any agreements/disagreements/clarifications to the January 4, 1999 joint proposal of RUCO and the Attorney General.


