ATTORNEY GENERAL AND RUCO'S SUMMARY OF PARTIES INTENDING TO PROPOSE MODIFICATIONS TO ELECTRIC COMPETITION RULES

Pursuant to Procedural Order dated January 26, 1999, the Attorney General and RUCO provide the following summary identifying those parties who corresponded their intent to file comments, objections and/or proposed modifications to the Arizona Corporation Commission Electric Restructuring Rules (the "Rules"). 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
