PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Procedural Order dated November 16, 2011, this matter was set for hearing to commence June 14, 2011, at the Arizona Corporation Commission's ("Commission") Tucson offices. The Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") and Mr. Lawrence Wawryzniak and Mr. James Schoemperlen have been granted intervention.

In an Open Meeting on February 2, 2011, the Commission voted to hold a public comment meeting in this matter in or near the local service area.

Consequently, Goodman Water Company ("GWC" or "Company") is directed to provide notice of the public comment meeting to its customers as set forth herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **Public Comment Meeting** in this matter shall commence on **May 18, 2011, at 2:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical at the **DesertView Performing Arts Center, 39900 S. Clubhouse Drive, Saddlebrooke, AZ 85739.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Company shall provide public notice of the public comment meeting in this matter, in the following type size, form and style with the heading in no less than 14 point bold type and the body in no less than 10-point regular type:

Summary

On September 17, 2010, Goodman Water Company ("Goodman" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an increase in annual revenues of \$291,083, or 50.82 percent over test year revenues. The Commission has scheduled an evidentiary hearing on the application to commence on June 14, 2011, at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's Tucson Offices, 400 W. Congress, Room 222, Tucson, Arizona 85701.

Under the rates as proposed by the Company, a residential customer with a 5/8 x 3/4" meter, with an average monthly usage of 5,477 gallons, would see a monthly increase of \$35.46, or 53.14 percent, from \$66.73 to \$102.19. This example is for illustrative purposes only, and the actual dollar and percentage changes for individual customers would vary depending on the type of customer served, and the quantity.

The Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") and two individuals have intervened in this matter, and will be able, along with the Commission's Staff, to offer evidence and make recommendations on the application. The direct testimony of Staff and intervenors is due to be filed on March 21, 2011.

The Commission will determine the appropriate rate relief to be granted based on the evidence of record in this proceeding, and is not bound by the proposals made by the Company, Staff, RUCO, or any other intervenor. Therefore, the final rates approved in this docket may be lower or higher than the rates described above.

4 **published at least twice** at in a newspaper of local circulation in its service territory, with
5 **publication to occur once during the week of May 2, 2011, and once during the week of May 9,**
6 **2011.**

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Company shall determine if there are public locations
8 (e.g., the DesertView Performing Arts Center, or a local clubhouse) in or near its service area where
9 the notice can be posted where it would be visible to Goodman ratepayers, and if possible, shall have
10 the notice posted in such location(s) during the two weeks prior to the public comment meeting.


11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Company shall file certification of mailing and
12 publication as soon as practicable after they have been completed.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice shall be deemed complete upon mailing and
14 publication of same, notwithstanding the failure of an individual customer to read or receive the
15 notice.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
17 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
18 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
20 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


