There has been a misunderstanding regarding the standpipe located at Bellemont Water, Inc. in Flagstaff, AZ.

Klaudia Ness, Secretary, has had possession of the standpipe from September 2006, when the business was acquired, until July 13, 2010. Brad Ness, President had possession of the standpipe from July 13, 2010 to November 15, 2010. Brad Ness resigned his position due to health.

I, Erik Ness, the new President had possession of the standpipe from November 15, 2010 to December 22, 2010.

Upon talking to Ayesha Vohra and receiving paperwork from the Corporation Commission, I Erik Ness understood that the Corporation Commission wanted me to stay away from the business. I also believed that the Corporation Commission had given all power back to Klaudia Ness, Secretary.

After meeting the Staff at the Corporation Commission on February 8, 2010, I realized that this was only a recommendation. I, as the President of Bellemont Water Company, Inc. made the decision to assign it over to the Vice President, Elliott Ness. I met with Elliott at the standpipe on February 9, 2010. At this time, Elliott and I checked the standpipe together. There was \$1,578.00. I gave Elliott the keys, which I thought no longer worked. He took the \$1,578.00; he is going to make the deposit, and will be responsible for future deposits.

I suggest that we leave Elliott Ness, Vice President in charge as he is the only officer that is not involved in the complaint at the Arizona Corporation Commission.

I, Erik Ness, President would like to thank the Staff that met with us on February 8, 2011. The meeting was informative and much appreciated.
