REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Francisco Grande Utilities Company (“Francisco Grande”) hereby requests an extension of the deadline to file exceptions to at least March 21, 2011, and requests that the Commission delay these matters for consideration until at least the Commission’s regularly-scheduled March 29-30, 2011, Open Meeting on utility matters. Francisco Grande requires additional time to determine the positions that it may take concerning the December 22, 2010, Recommended Opinion and Order (“ROO”).

The major issue addressed in the ROO was the request to approve a Settlement Agreement between Arizona Water Company (“Arizona Water”), Global Water Resources LLC (“Global”), and various Global affiliates, including at that time Francisco Grande. Another issue was a request to approve the transfer of Francisco Grande’s water and sewer CC&Ns to two Global affiliates.


As more fully described in two pleadings—Arizona Water’s and Global’s December 30, 2011, Request for Extension, and Global’s February 16, 2011, Motion to Withdraw the Francisco Grande Transfer Application—Global no longer owns Francisco Grande. Because of this fact, much of the record underlying the ROO is no longer accurate.

1 First, the record evidence is that Francisco Grande is a party to the Settlement Agreement
2 and supports all its terms, including supporting Commission approval of designated planning
3 areas for Arizona Water and Global. This evidence is no longer accurate. Global's planning
4 area would include Francisco Grande's nineteen-square mile water service area and forty-two-
5 square-mile sewer service area. Francisco Grande has not finalized its position, but likely will
6 no longer support the Settlement Agreement, including the planning-area designations.

7 Second, the record included evidence supporting an application to transfer Francisco
8 Grande's CC&Ns to Global affiliates. Global has already moved to withdraw this application.
9 Most likely, Francisco Grande will also move to withdraw the application.

10 Because of very recent events, Francisco Grande requires additional time to determine its
11 positions in these dockets and to file appropriate pleadings. Due process therefore requires that
12 Francisco Grande be provided additional time to file exceptions and that the Commission delay
13 consideration of these matters until at least its March 29-20, Utility Open Meeting.

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
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
