**CHAPARRAL CITY WATER
COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR
CORRECTION**

13 Chaparral City Water Company ("CCWC" or the "Company") hereby submits this
14 request for correction to the Recommended Opinion and Order ("ROO") issued on
15 February 11, 2011.

16 CCWC requests that the ROO be corrected to include new rates. By way of brief
17 explanation, the ROO recommends a new revenue requirement of \$9,388,080, which is
18 \$118,699 more than the current revenue requirement, and also recommends a surcharge to
19 collect the amount of forgone revenue. However, the ROO does not recommend new
20 rates to allow CCWC to recover the new revenue requirement. CCWC believes that the
21 additional amount can be collected by a \$.06 increase in the commodity rates for all
22 customers.

23 CCWC suggests that the following Ordering Paragraphs be inserted into the ROO
24 beginning on **page 12, line 22**:

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1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 40-252 and 40-
2 253, Decision No. 71308, as amended *nunc pro tunc* by Decision No. 71424, is further
3 amended to allow Chaparral City Water Company to recover the new revenue
4 requirement by increasing the monthly commodity rates by \$.06. The Company is
5 hereby authorized and directed to file, by March 31, 2011, a tariff reflecting
6 commodity rates as set forth below.
