PROCEDURAL ORDER
SETTING PROCEDURAL
CONFERENCE

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 2, 2011, Arizona-American Water Company (“Arizona-American” or “Applicant”) filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) an application for a waiver under A.A.C. R14-2-806 or, in the alternative, Notice of Intent to Reorganize under A.A.C. R14-2-803 (“Application and Notice”).

On March 4, 2011, the Residential Utility Office (“RUCO”) filed an Application to Intervene.

A procedural conference should be held for the purpose of discussing the processing of the Application and Notice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **procedural conference** in the above-captioned matter shall commence on **March 22, 2011, at 2:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission’s offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room 1, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission’s Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (e) of the Rules of Civil Procedure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
2 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
3 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at all
4 hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled
5 for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
6 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
8 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
9 hearing.


