Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-105, The Water Utility Association of Arizona
(WUAA) hereby moves the Commission for leave to intervene in the above-captioned
proceeding. The Water Utility Association of Arizona is a non-profit corporation representing the
investor-owned segment of the water industry in the state of Arizona. The association has a
regular membership of approximately 100 investor-owned water companies, serving from 1 to

1 400,000 customers.

2 The purpose of the Association is to promote regulatory policies that will: promote
3 investment, encourage conservation and protect consumers in order to ensure that Arizona has
4 adequate supplies of safe, affordable water—as well as the infrastructure required to deliver that
5 water to consumers at affordable prices.

6 Arizona American Water Company is a member of the WUAA and several of the policy
7 issues addressed in the Application have broad implications for the private water industry.

8 The granting of intervenor status to the WUAA will not unduly delay the proceedings or
9 cause the issues to be unduly broadened. The WUAA requests that all communications in
10 connection with the above-captioned proceedings be directed to:


