Q. Please provide copies of the minutes of all Goodman Water Company board of Directors meetings.

A. The Company objects to this data request on the following grounds. First, the data request seeks information of a confidential and proprietary nature from the records of a private, closely-held corporation. Second, the requesting parties have cited no provision of Arizona law which entitles them to access to the requested information. Third, as currently written the data request is unduly broad as to the nature of the information requested in relation to the issues to be addressed and resolved in the instant rate case. In that regard, and without waiving its right to further objection, the Company is willing to consider possibly responding to a revised data request which specifically identifies subjects directly relevant to the instant rate case.

As an alternative, the Company is prepared to submit copies of the requested minutes to the Administrative Law Judge assigned to the instant rate case on an in camera basis, and let her determine what portions of the same are relevant to the issues to be resolved by the Commission.
