



On September 3, 2010, Arizona-American Water Company, Inc. ("Arizona-American" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for permanent rate increases for its following Districts: Agua Fria Water district, Havasu Water district, and Mohave Water district.

For its Agua Fria Water district, Arizona-American's application requests an annual revenue increase of approximately \$17,879,283 or 79.1 percent over current revenues. For average consumption (7,362 gallons per month) 3/6 x 4/4 inch meter residential customers of the Agua Fria Water district, Arizona-American's request would increase monthly rates by 82.89 percent or \$25.13. 




