PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Continues Hearing)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 18, 2011, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Attila G. Toth (CRD# 2565633) and Erin M. Hall, husband and wife (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of notes and stock. Respondent Attila Toth's spouse, Erin M. Hall, was joined in the action for purposes of determining the liability of the marital community.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On January 27, 2011, Respondent, Attila G. Toth, filed a request for hearing in this matter.

On January 28, 2011, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on February 23, 2011.

On February 23, 2011, the Division appeared through counsel and Respondent Attila G. Toth appeared on his own behalf. Counsel for the Division indicated that the parties were attempting to reach a settlement in the proceeding and would submit a proposed form of Consent Order for approval by the Commission. In the interim, the Division requested that a hearing be scheduled in the event that the parties did not reach a resolution of the issues raised by the Notice.

On February 28, 2011, the Division filed a Motion to Continue ("Motion") the hearing due to the unavailability of a witness in the proceeding. There have been no objections filed to the Division's Motion.

1 Accordingly, the Motion should be granted and the hearing continued.

2 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED a **hearing shall be continued from May 26, 2011, to June**
3 **28, 2011, at 9:30 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, **Hearing Room**
4 **No. 1**, Phoenix, Arizona.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall reserve **June 29, 2011**, for an additional
6 day of hearing, if necessary.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **Division and Respondent shall exchange copies of**
8 **their Witness Lists and copies of the Exhibits by May 27, 2011**, with courtesy copies provided to
9 the presiding Administrative Law Judge.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **if the case is resolved by proposed Consent Order prior**
11 **to the hearing, the Division shall file a Motion to Vacate the Proceeding.**

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
13 Communications) is in effect and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision in this
14 matter is final and non-appealable.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
16 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission
17 *pro hac vice*.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance
19 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
20 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances
21 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
22 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
23 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
2 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
3 ruling at hearing.


