**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE WITH
DECISION NUMBER 72094
REGARDING METER
INSTALLATION AND READING**

On February 18, 2011, in accordance with the Decision Number 72094 of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") dated January 19, 2011 ("Decision"), Kohl's Ranch Water Company ("Kohl's Ranch") notified the ACC that it had complied with ACC's Decision requiring that:

- "Kohl's Ranch Water Company shall, within 30 days after the effective date of this Decision, ensure that appropriately sized meters are obtained, if necessary, and are installed to measure the water flowing from the spring source into the Spring System and flowing between the Well System and the Spring System;" and
- "within 60 days after the effective date of this Decision, Kohl's Ranch Water Company shall file with the Commission's Docket Control, as a compliance item in this docket, documentation confirming that such meters are installed, identifying the meter size at each location, and attesting that Kohl's Ranch Water Company has begun to take regular readings from the meters and will continue to do so."

(See Decision at 31-32.)

Specifically, Kohl's Ranch stated:

In its December 30, 2010 filing entitled "Applicant Kohl's Ranch Water Company's Exception to the Recommended Opinion and Order," incorporated herein by reference, Kohl's Ranch confirmed that the meters required to be installed by the

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Decision (“Meters”) had been installed and provided documentation confirming their installation and size. Kohl’s Ranch also attested at that time that the Meters were and will continue to be read daily and that the readings from the meters are logged.

(See Revised Schedule of Rates and Charges for Service and Notice of Compliance with Decision Number 70294 at 1.)

The December 30, 2010 filing states that Kohl’s Ranch:

has confirmed that the required meters are already in place. “Meter 1” measures the water flowing into the spring system. It is a 3” meter located in the chlorinator building. “Meter 2” measures the water that flows between the well system and the spring system. It is a 2” meter located by the hydro tank in the pump building.



In its December 30, 2010 filing, Kohl’s Ranch also attested “these two meters [Meter 1 and Meter 2] are now and will continue to be read daily and the readings from the meters are logged.” (*Id.* at 6, ll. 25-26.)
