Summary

On November 22, 2010, Arizona Public Service Company, ("APS") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for approval of the purchase of Southern California Edison's portion of Four Corners Generating Units 4 and 5, located in Fruitland, NM, and for an accounting order to defer certain costs associated with the transaction. Commission approval of the proposed transaction is required by Commission Decision No. 67744 (April 7, 2005). If the transaction receives all requisite approvals and is consummated, APS would close Units 1-3.

About Intervention

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission no later than **[insert date]**. You must send a copy of the motion to intervene to APS or its counsel and to all parties of record, which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself;
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer, stockholder of APS, etc.); and
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to APS or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before **[insert date]**. among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. Failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the application or from filing written comments in the record of the case
