PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 2, 2009, Arizona-American Water Company ("Arizona-American," "AAWC," or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for rate increases for its Anthem Water District, Sun City Water District, Anthem/Agua Fria Wastewater District, Sun City Wastewater District, and Sun City West Wastewater District.

Intervention in this matter was granted to the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO"); Anthem Community Council ("Council"); Sun City West Property Owners and Residents Association ("PORA"); W.R. Hansen; the Water Utility Association of Arizona; the Camelback Inn,

1 Sanctuary on Camelback Mountain, the Intercontinental Montelucia Resort and Spa, and the
2 Scottsdale Cottonwoods Resort and Suites (collectively the "Resorts"); the Town of Paradise Valley;
3 the Anthem Golf and Country Club; Marshall Magruder; DMB White Tank, LLC; ; Mashie, LLC dba
4 Corte Bella Golf Club; Larry D. Woods;¹ and Philip H. Cook.

5 On January 6, 2011, the Commission issued Decision No. 72047 in this docket. Decision
6 No. 72047 left this docket open for the sole purpose of considering the design and implementation of
7 stand-alone revenue requirements and rate designs for the Anthem Wastewater district and Agua Fria
8 Wastewater district as agreed to in the Agreement reached by the Company, the Council, RUCO and
9 the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") during the Open Meeting at which Decision No. 72047
10 was considered.² Decision No. 72047 ordered the Company to file, by April 1, 2011, an application
11 supporting consideration of stand-alone revenue requirements and rate designs as set forth in that
12 Agreement ("Application").

13 On April 1, 2011, the Company filed the Application as a compliance item in this docket.
14 The filing included direct testimony and exhibits.

15 The Application states that Arizona-American mailed a copy of the Application to all parties
16 on the service list for this docket. Arizona-American requests that in order to avoid confusion and to
17 reduce copying, assembling, and postage costs, that existing parties be required to affirmatively
18 request continuing inclusion in the service list for this docket.

19 If a party no longer wishes to receive copies of future filings in this docket, the party may file
20 a request to be removed from the service list.

21 A procedural conference should be scheduled in order to provide an opportunity for
22 discussion of a procedural schedule, public notice, and other procedural issues prior to the issuance of
23 a procedural order governing the processing of the Application.

24 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **procedural conference** shall be held on **April 19,**
25 **2011, commencing at 2:00 p.m.,** or as soon thereafter as practicable, at the Commission's offices,
26 1200 West Washington Street, **Hearing Room 1,** Phoenix, Arizona. Parties who intend to



1 participate in the proceeding on the Application shall attend the procedural conference and be
2 prepared to discuss a procedural schedule, public notice, and any other procedural issues relating to
3 the processing of the Application.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any party who no longer wishes to receive copies of future
5 filings in this docket may file a written request to be removed from the service list. Upon receipt of
6 the written request, the party will be deleted from the service list, and the remaining parties will not
7 be required to serve that party with copies of filings.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
9 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
10 hearing.
